Janmashtami Celebration

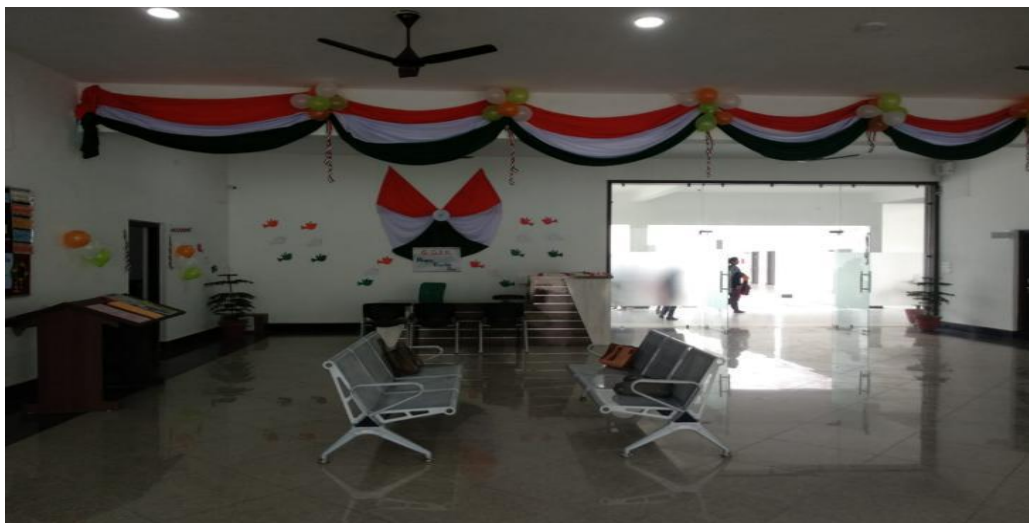

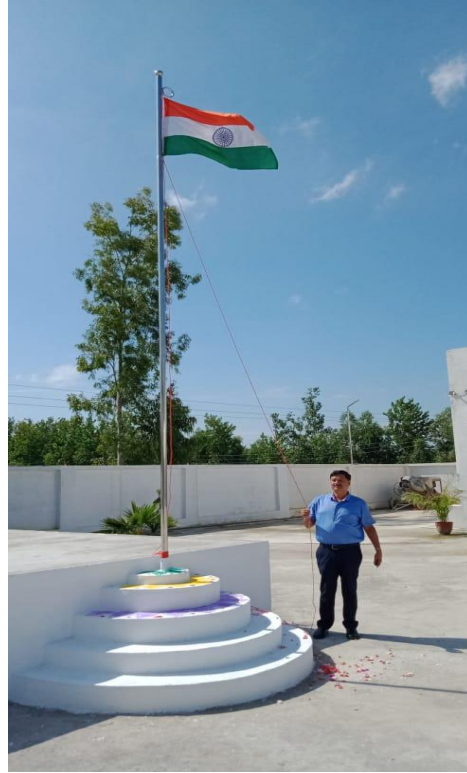
Children came dressed in ethnic wear as Radha and Krishna. It was a beautiful day filled with joyous melody.
